

The Eucharist

St Paul reminded the early Church of Jesus' teaching that they should all be united into one body – the Church. This worksheet invites you to identify where you see St Paul's teaching lived out in the world today, as well as instances of people's failure to live up to the ideal that St Paul spoke of. Read 1 Corinthians 12:12–26, in which St Paul reminds the early Church of Jesus' teaching that they should all be united into one body – the Church.

With a partner or in a small group, share examples of where you see the teaching of St Paul lived out in the world today.

Share examples of where you see signs of people's failure to live up to this ideal.

Artists down through the centuries have sought to depict the Eucharist and what it represents. This worksheet invites you first to find passages from the scriptures that are directly connected to the Sacrament of the Eucharist and then to research works of art that depict the events described in those passages.

Work in groups.
