At the Transfiguration Peter said to Jesus, 'Let's stay on this mountain and build three dwellings' (Mark 9:5). But the Transfiguration was the prelude to the Revelation of the path the Son of God was to travel to fulfil his mission. Jesus' final days in Jerusalem would reveal that path, a path Peter and other disciples found to be 'unbelievable'. After the Transfiguration the Son of Man announced it was time for him to leave the mountain, move on and 'go through many sufferings and be treated with contempt' (Mark 9:12).
